2011-2012 Player/Parent Agreement

Nevada Elite Football Club is dedicated to developing girls' soccer in Northern Nevada. In order to be a successful youth soccer club, we must ensure clear, consistent communication between the Club, its Teams and Coaches, Players and Parents. This agreement will explain the Club's expectations of you as a Club member. Please read the following carefully and ask questions if anything is unclear to you.

Your Commitment. You have committed to being a member of the Club for Fall 2011 through Spring 2012. The Club will not release a player from their obligation absent cause. If you want a release, you must first meet with the team coach and Technical Director to resolve any issues. If the issues cannot be resolved, then the Club may consider a release after all fees are paid. Players who are receiving a scholarship will not be released until all fees are paid (the scholarship will be withdrawn) absent extraordinary circumstances.

Playing Time/Positions. All player issues (playing time, positions played, etc.) will be the coach's responsibility. If you have an issue, you may bring it up with the coach as provided below, or with the Technical Director.

Communication with Players. If, as a player, you have a question about any matter (playing time, position, etc.), then you are encouraged to discuss that matter with your coach(es). The Club asks all parents to please encourage and teach your daughters to take the initiative and speak up and communicate for themselves whenever possible.

Communication with Parents. If, as a parent, you have a question, you should feel free to communicate with the coach(es). Please e-mail or call the coach(es) and request a time at which you can meet to discuss the matter. This will allow the coach(es) to be prepared to answer your questions in a meaningful manner. If you have a question regarding your daughter's playing time, position, or other matters in which the decisions of the coach are in issue, please do not approach the coach until at least 24 hours have passed after the conclusion of a game. Club coaches are not obligated to discuss such matters with parents after a game.

Disciplinary Matters. Any matter involving inappropriate conduct of a Player or Parent, including any violation of the Club Bylaws, rules, or this Agreement, may be referred to the Club's Board of Directors and/or Disciplinary Committee for action.

Fundraising/Volunteering. Every family is expected to volunteer time to the Club. The Club will begin an aggressive fundraising process this year that will become part of the Club's structure going forward. The purpose of the fundraising is to maintain and/or reduce player fees, support Club initiatives and infrastructure, and help players in financial need. All families are expected to volunteer time at the Club's hosted tournaments in June and/or July.

Player Agreement. I understand that playing for **Nevada Elite FC** is a privilege. As a Nevada **Elite FC** player, I will:

1. Work hard in school, get the best grades that I can and provide grade reports to the coach if requested.
2. Respect the Game, my coaches, teammates, parents and our Club, as well as all referees, opposing players and coaches.
3. Always represent our Club and my team in a positive manner.
4. Be committed by attending all training sessions, training on my own, and limiting activities that conflict during the season.
5. Play my hardest in all training sessions and games.
6. Be ready and on time for all practices and games. I am responsible for getting to training sessions and games on time.
7. Be positive and encourage and support our Club and my teammates on and off the soccer field. I will not criticize or make fun of our Club, its coaches, or my teammates at any time.
8. Take responsibility for my soccer equipment, uniform kit, training uniform, warm-ups, bag and ball.
9. Remove all makeup and jewelry prior to every training session and game. I will not be allowed to participate until I do.
10. Talk to my coach(es) if I have a question or issue, or do not understand something.

6. Assist my daughter in fulfilling her obligations as a Club player and the requirements of this Player/Parent Agreement.
7. Meet all financial obligations in a timely manner as a condition of my daughter playing with the Club.
